

Science and Technology Rules and Information

Below are the lab rules and class information. The student will not be allowed to participate in any of the labs until this sheet is brought back signed.

Safety Lab Rules

1. Students must act responsibly in the lab and follow instructions given by the teacher. Failure to do so may result in the loss of lab privileges while, still being responsible for lab reports. Only teacher authorized activities are permitted.
2. Students must wear proper laboratory attire as designated by the teacher. Long hair must be tied back and safety goggles must be worn. The student can purchase a pair of goggles from the school for \$7.00. (C144)
3. Students must take proper care of lab equipment. Students will have to reimburse the school for any broken or missing equipment.

Class information

1. A valid note is needed for any missed test. A mark of zero will be given for skipping a test. No re-tests are given.
2. A student has one extra day to hand in a project or lab with no mark penalty. After that, the student has a maximum of three days to hand in the assignment with a loss of 10% per day. Weekends count for 2 days. After this a mark of zero will be given.
3. Tutoring will be given in B-209 at lunch on days 3, 5 and 10, or when requested.
4. If your child is experiencing difficulty in class, you will be notified either with a phone call, e-mail or a progress report will be sent home.
5. Extended time is already factored into projects when the due date is given.
